- 2. The sermon challenged the idea that community is optional. What obstacles (time, pride, fear, busyness) might be keeping you from engaging deeply in Christian community?
- 3. How do you respond when Jesus doesn't meet your 'obvious' need first? Jesus forgave the man's sins before healing his body. Has there ever been a time when Jesus addressed a deeper need in your life before the one you thought was most urgent?
- 4. The story says "Jesus saw their faith." In what ways is your faith visible to others? How can you live out a faith that stirs belief in those around you?
- 5. The crowd was amazed by what they witnessed. As a believer, what still amazes you about Jesus? What are you celebrating, contemplating, or chasing that reveals what amazes you most?
