



### Do Not Disturb: Part 3 - Discussion Questions "Tear Off The Roof" // Matt Noblitt

1. The paralyzed man had four friends willing to carry him and tear off a roof to get him to Jesus. Who in your life shows up like that when you're in need? Are you that person for someone else?
2. The sermon challenged the idea that community is optional. What obstacles (time, pride, fear, busyness) might be keeping you from engaging deeply in Christian community?
3. How do you respond when Jesus doesn't meet your 'obvious' need first? Jesus forgave the man's sins before healing his body. Has there ever been a time when Jesus addressed a deeper need in your life before the one you thought was most urgent?
4. The story says "*Jesus saw their faith.*" In what ways is your faith visible to others? How can you live out a faith that stirs belief in those around you?
5. The crowd was amazed by what they witnessed. As a believer, what still amazes you about Jesus? What are you celebrating, contemplating, or chasing that reveals what amazes you most?
