

For God So Loved Gwinnett Week Two Discussion Questions

- 1. Have you ever been excited to share something you're interested in with someone else—a podcast, a book, an exercise routine? What made you excited to share?
- 2. If you've ever had an opportunity to share your faith with someone, how did you feel? Were you nervous? Did it feel intrusive? Were you excited about it?
- 3. Reed described Paul's method for evangelism as investing in relationships. Paul spent time with people. He was caring, encouraging, and cheered them on. Have you thought of evangelism this way before?
- 4. If you're a Jesus follower, was there someone who shared the gospel with you? Did they invite you to church, pray for you, or show up for you when you needed it?
- 5. Who can you pray for this week that needs to know God loves them? How can you invest in your relationship with them?
