Discussion Questions

- 3. Read Luke 10:25–37. How does Jesus redefine neighbor with this parable?
- 4. How can loving others like Jesus loves help change the perception of Christians?
- 5. Have you ever experienced love from someone who loves like Jesus? How did it affect you?
