Discussion Questions

1. Who's the most likeable person you know? What makes them likeable?
2. Describe someone you find unlikeable or annoying (don't use names). What makes them annoying? Does that keep you from spending time with them?

Read Luke 15:1–10.

1. Who does God like? What types of people and characteristics is he drawn to?
2. How do you think the shepherd felt when he realized his sheep was lost?
3. Have you ever lost something? How did it feel?
4. Do you remember when you first chose to follow Jesus (if you are a Christian)? How did your friends and family respond?
5. Rahul encouraged us to expand our God box. What is your God box? What does it presently look like?
6. What steps can you take this week to expand your God box? Who is someone you have counted out that you can reach out to and spend time with?

Moving Forward

Next Steps for Expanding Your God Box

1. Pray for a heart to see people like God sees them (as sons and daughters of God).
2. Take a step and invite someone to dinner or coffee.
3. Invest in them, pray for them, and celebrate them.

Read this Scripture aloud daily: “Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Doesn’t she light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it? And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, ‘Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.’ In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.” (Luke 15:8–10)
