Week One - Joel Thomas - Come and See

Discussion Questions

1. Can you think of something you've witnessed that is so extraordinary that it defies explanation? Maybe it's a place, an experience, an event that feels historic, or something that simply must be experienced by someone.
2. Read John 1:35–38. How would you answer if Jesus were to turn to you and ask, "What do you want?" Is there a reason you are actually following him?
3. If Jesus simply instructs us to "come and see," how does this reframe the prerequisites of following him? What did you grow up thinking was required?
4. If your life is a "show-and-tell," what would people guess is the motivating force guiding your life?
5. Do you intentionally spend time getting to know Jesus on a day-to-day basis? Would you describe it as "abiding" in him? Has it changed how you live your life?
6. What part of "love in action" described in 1 Corinthians 13:4–7 do you personally struggle with? Can you think of any tangible steps you can take this week to work on being more Christ-like?
