- 5. When we forgive someone (or are trying to), we can:
  - Pray for them.
  - Speak well of them.
  - Do good for them.

Which one of these is most difficult for you? What makes you say that?

6. Think of a "debt" that someone owes you that could never be repaid. Have you forgiven that person? If not, what's holding you back?
