- 3. If it's true the church in America is in decline, what would it take to reverse that trend? Would you say you're currently helping reverse that trend? What makes you say that?
- 4. Our mission is to inspire people to follow Jesus. We do that by engaging people with the life and mission of a local church. Here are three ways you can participate in that:
 - Look for "Come sit with me" opportunities. Listen for the three "nots" and be ready to invite someone (not in church, not going well, not prepared for life circumstances).
 - When was the last time you asked someone to come sit with you? What happened?
 - Do you have any hesitations in asking someone to come sit with you? If so, what are they?
 - Participate in a small group.
 - If you are in a group, is it time to consider leading one? Why or why not?
 - If you're not currently in a group, would you consider joining one? If not, what are your hesitations?

- Do you volunteer at your local church?
- If so, talk about your experience doing that. If not, what are your hesitations in volunteering?
